Dapper Dave wins the February Shoot

Six cowboys rode in for the February Shoot, held in the cold and sleet (or was that snow?) at the Little River Sportsman's Association range on February 8, 2003.

Dapper Dave and **Big Boyd** tied on points, and using total time as a tie-breaker, **Dapper Dave** came out on top by about 7½ seconds.

Dixie Outlaw is getting more consistent shooting Gunfighter with those Vaqueros. He had to be a little creative with the scenarios to shoot Gunfighter, but it worked out pretty well for him.

Except for scenario 2, **Papa Jake** was a consistent third place, even while shooting a borrowed rifle. He was certainly dressed up in his new holster rig! Those stainless Vaqueros really shine in that black rig.

Tallokas Kid looked to have just ridden in from the range in his new hat and slicker. That big brim helped him catch those shells from his Henry.

It was good to see **Chickasaw County Kid** back, in spite of his being down in the back.

The first Scenario, based on the movie *Unforgiven*, required the cowboy to attempt to shoot five bowling pins off a rail with his pistol, one handed. Any left standing had to be engaged with the shotgun. Both **Dapper Dave** and **Big Boyd** cleared the rail with less than five shots, some of the pins falling into other pins and knocking them off the rail. Both these cowboys found themselves with the hammer cocked, and no targets left. According to our safety rules, the pistol had to be fired, so the cowboy does not holster his pistol with a loaded round under the hammer. Next time we use this scenario, we must put each pin on a separate stand! The shot pattern on the pins left by **Dixie Outlaw**'s scatter-gun showed that it has the tightest pattern out there.

Even with a miss on a procedural on the second scenario (he left Tuco hanging) **Dapper Dave** still recorded the

best time on that scenario.

The closest to a clean run was **Big Boyd** with only one miss. **Tallokas Kid** had only two misses.

Everybody pitched in to make this an enjoyable time. The moving of tables and chairs before and after the match, he spotting, recording and picking up of the brass were duties shared by one and all.
