Rhinestone Rimfire Match

On the fifth Saturday in September (September 30) we will try a new kind of match – A Rhinestone Cowboy Match – You need a .22 pistol (semi-auto, single or double action revolver with open sights) a .22 repeating rifle with 10 round capacity (lever, slide, bolt or semi-auto action – open sights) and a single shot shotgun.. Bring 100 rounds of .22 ammo, and a box of shotgun shells. We will shoot cowboy targets. Fee - \$5.00 (juniors free with paid adult). Signup at 8:15, safety meeting at 9:00, then about 5 scenarios.

October Shootout

The shootout in October will be held on October 7, 2006, with signup beginning at 8:00am and the safety meeting beginning at 9:00am. The fee for this shoot will be \$10, \$5 for juniors (free with a paid adult). We plan on about five or six scenarios, and will try to be

done by 1:00pm. Y'all round up about a few more shooters, and when we have 20, we'll split into two posses, and get done a little sooner!

.22 One-Gun Match

On Saturday, September 16, 2006, there will be a **.22 One-Gun Match** at the **Little River Sportsmen's Association** Range. We will have three classes of weapons – **Unlimited Pistol** (semi-auto with scope), **Stock Pistol** (semi-auto with open sights), **Revolver** (open sights, no compensators). We will use the same pistol to shoot a 30-round bullseye match, a 20-animal silhouette match and 3 stages of steel plates. 150 rounds of ammo should be plenty. Match fee is \$10 (juniors \$5 or free with paid adult). Safety meeting begins at 9:00 sharp.

IPSC matches

Lee Ovaert, is running a modified IPSC match on our cowboy range on the 4th Saturday of each month, starting at 9:30am. The fee is \$15. He usually sets up five stages with a round count under 150 rounds (but not much less than 150). Get out that old 1911 or that old S&W revolver and come shoot another action-type match.
